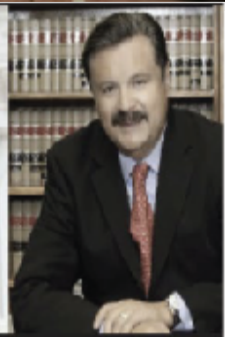

Willie Velasquez Voting Rights Icon

If you are a minority elected to office in the last 40 years, chances are you owe it in part to Willie. Not because he was the founder of MAYO (Mexican American Youth Organization). Not because he was once the Boycott coordinator for UFW in the Rio Grande Valley. Probably not for his work as a field director for the Southwest Council of La Raza, or La Raza Unida party founder with Jose Angel Gutierrez.

Pero all those roles were ones he had on the way to a Presidential Medal of Honor presented to him posthumously by President Bill Clinton in 1995. In addition, despite Republican opposition on May 9th, 2014, on what would have been his 70th birthday, Texas Legislature authorized a Willie Velasquez Day. Unfortunately, Mr. Velasquez died in 1988 from complications from kidney cancer at the age of 44. According to those that were close to him, he suddenly started feeling ill, was diagnosed with cancer, and sadly a month later, he passed. His work and that of the SWVP changed Texas politics forever, and this is how and why he did it.

After seeing the success and the demise of the Raza Unida Party, he created something more lasting and narrative changing. So, he then spent years starting in 1970-71, creating the Southwest Voter Project. And after much planning and raising seed money in 1974, he finally opened his office with a folding chair, a borrowed rotary phone, and a small desk. The overall goal was to increase minority voter participation in the political single-member districts in the name of

process, especially Latinos in the Southwest. Mr. Velasquez determined this was the only way for Latino empowerment.

Initially, the process involved getting more people in marginalized communities registered to vote through community-based voter drives. However, rather than just sending paid staff from their office to run the drives, they recruited directly from the target city or community. The premise here was to recruit someone already connected and trusted in the community to head their own community project. Once that person was chosen and vetted, they would then travel to the Texas Headquarters for SWVP for training, which is how I was lucky enough to meet Mr. Velasquez and go through organizational leadership training that he and others at the project developed. Willie was a charismatic leader, and you could not help but listen to his every word. And you believed what he told you because the passion in his voice meant that he believed in what he was saying. Once trained, you became an official project organizer ready to go home and go to work.

In some communities, the increase in minority voters had an immediate impact on city and county elections. The face of city and county government was more reflective of all its citizens. However, not everywhere, many Latinos would say, "Why vote, we never elect the people we vote for." And most times, they were right. Initially, the response from the SWVP was to register even more people, but again in most cases, the same results. A closer study revealed that in cities where all political candidates were elected at large, anyone with a Latino surname stood no chance at majority White cities. So, to be clear, you could live and run out of a district that was 70% Latino, but if the city were majority White and your name was Gonzalez, "No way, Jose. "This practice of At-Large voting was along with gerrymandering; voter intimidation was a lasting part of the Jim Crow era. Unfortunately, this year's president's election has brought back some old obstacles and some new twists.

This led to first asking those cities with at-large elections to change to

COMMUNITY OWNERSHIP OF POLICE

"In a civilized and rule-by-law society, law and order starts with those charged

with maintaining law and order to conduct themselves in an unequivocal lawful

and orderly manner. When they don't the system breaks down."

Across the United States there has been numerous protests and demonstrations prompted by recent national images and videos of ethnic minorities killed in the custody of police has once again have awakened our social consciousness. People from all social and economic backgrounds are demanding police reform and, in some instances, people are calling to defund the police. Regardless on which side of the spectrum you are in police reform one thing is certain – police reform is absolutely necessary. The only question remaining unanswered is how and to what extent?

Closer to home, Arlington is no exception to questionable police shootings of ethnic minorities in recent years and there are certainly some areas in need for improvement. But before I state my case for police reform it is necessary to fully disclose my background in police work so I may be somewhat qualified to speak to this subject matter.

First and foremost, I do not claim to be a police expert. I did work as a "street cop" police officer for nine years some years ago in a rough bor-

der town in Texas. During my tenure I came across unimaginable gruesome crime scenes; a "partner" of mine was killed in the line of duty and two others committed suicide. To say I witnessed a lot of "s____" is an understatement. I also served as the local police association president. In this capacity I assisted with the representation of police officers charged with misconduct. This role was an eye opener as to the other "human side" of the police profession. In addition, I was actively involved with a police advocacy group who pushed for "meet and confer" and "civil service" legislation at the state capitol.

Secondly, I am not anti-police, but I do support police reform. And while this editorial is primarily aimed at the City of Arlington, the recommendation herein may easily be applied to other city police departments. And last, I hope this narrative is informative and adds to the discussion, debate, and decision in support for a better police department in Arlington. Let us start the brief examination with a "What If Scenario". What if you have 640 police officers and 630 are "good cops" and 10 are "bad cops", and the 630 "good cops" don't turn in the 10 "bad cops"? What you have now are 640 "bad cops". This "what if" sheds light to a long suspected "police code" – cops do not tell on cops. Given my experience I am inclined to say this may be true in some cases but to what extent is the million-dollar question.

Why Police Reform? - Because the current system in place for many years is undoubtedly broken. The Mayor-City Council form of government which ultimately oversees police officer's conduct has proven to be ineffective, unaccountable, intransparent, detrimen-

tal to community interests, and socially unacceptable. This very same system of police oversight – the Mayor and City Council - allows police employee associations to funnel thousands of dollars into the Mayor's and Council member's election coffers. In short, the current police oversight system is politicized. Be mindful that the Mayor and City Council provide two significant concessions to the police association: "meet and confer" agreements and "arbitration hearings" for disciplinary actions against police officers. Both of these measures have proven to be restraints against police accountability and transparency; two of the most important community concerns driving police reform.

So how can this broken system of police oversight be fix? One sure way is to remove police oversight from the Mayor-City Council and render it to the community. The most reasonable recommendation would be the following:

Establish and fund a Community Police Oversight Board charged with the oversight of police operations inclusive of the policies and procedures for the recruitment, selection, placement, promotion, recognition, discipline, and termination of police officers.

The police oversight system is broken, and Arlington's community activists are pushing for police reform to provide for a better police department that "serves and protects" the community and is "accountable" to the community. After all, the community pays the police officers' salaries and benefits. The drum beat for proponents of police reform should be unmistakably loud and clear – community ownership of police.

Before LULAC, UFW & Chicano Movement There Was Jovita

Jovita Idár was a bright, artistic young girl who greatly admired her father, Nicasio Idár. Nicasio was a dedicated activist and often brought to light the gruesome realities of being Mexican American in the early 1900s. He was the publisher and editor of *La Crónica*. This publication often exposed the horrors of lynching like in the case of Antonio Rodríguez, who was accused of murdering an Anglo woman then hunted and lynched. *La Crónica* also acknowledged the need for equal rights and education for Mexican Americans, as their mission statement read, "We work for the progress and the industrial, moral and intellectual development of the Mexican inhabitants of Texas." Nicasio was truly ahead of his time and paved the way for the Chicano movement. His young daughter watched on as her valiant father broke boundaries, and she would grow up to do the same.

Jovita was incredibly studious but had an artistic side to her and often won prizes for her poetry. In 1903 she earned her teaching certificate. She got her first teaching job at a school just 40 miles out from Laredo. She soon realized the difficulties of being a Mexican American student in a segregated school and became frustrated with the lack of proper supplies and reading material. Taxes paid by those living in these neighborhoods were meant to provide quality education, but they were not even supplied with chairs for all students. She knew action had to be taken.

With the same spirit as her father, Jovita turned to one of her earliest passions- writing. She returned home to work with her two brothers at *La Crónica* and became a Journalist. Alongside her family, she empowered Latinos to speak up for the rights to an equal education. In 1911, *La Crónica* held the First Mexican Congress (the Primer Congreso Mexicano). The new organization united Mexicans on issues that impacted them, including lack of access to adequate education and economic resources. At the same time, Jovita served as the first president of

the League of Mexican Women. These two organizations worked together to enhance the Latino community, and members benefited from additional teachings to further their studies. While the first Mexican Congress focused on civil liberties, the League of Mexican Women urged for more social programs and gathered donations for families in need. Jovita and her activist friend's ability to multi-task was astounding as just on the other side of the border, the Mexican Revolution was seething and could not be ignored.

On March 1913, Nuevo Laredo—on the Mexican side of the border—was attacked; Jovita joined the La Cruz Blanca (the White Cross) to help those injured. Her experience of the involvement of US troops at the Mexican border would not be forgotten.

She returned home the following year and began to write for *El Progreso*, another progressive publication. She was quick to unmask the real character of President Woodrow Wilson and his decision to unleash the Texas Rangers and US army at the Mexican border. Texas Rangers were enraged by her writings and attempted to shut down the newspaper. Jovita refused to go down without a fight and blocked the entrance to *El Progreso*. Unfortunately, they gained access and destroyed the building. That same year her father passed away, and she became Publisher and Editor of *La Crónica*. Jovita Idár would eventually found her own weekly publication *Evolución* in 1916. But her passion for education never wavered and in 1921 founded a free kindergarten in San Antonio Texas.

Before LULAC, National Farm Workers Association, Southwest Voter- there was the Idár family. The real OGs of the Chicano movement.

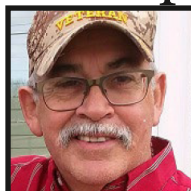

This illustrates that rational people can easily become irrational if fear overtakes their rational thinking.

Today, American citizens are being divided by fear once again. I listened to the Republican and Democratic conventions; I saw two psyches at work. The Republican convention appealed to fear: they will take your guns, democrats are destroying this country, the country is getting worse because we do not pray in school, they will take your religious freedom, they do not support police officers, they will defund police officers, they will change the basic fabric of America, they are Socialist, they will destroy this country, take your liberty, they will control what you see and think, they will disrespect the flag, etc. Trump disrespected the flag when he refused to serve this country in the military, and none of his children have served. Yet now they lie that only Trump can save this country. This fear-mongering is coming from the age-old cookbook on how to manipulate people using fear. Americans need to abandon fear and clothe themselves with the optimism that once put a man on the moon and truly embrace the idea that united we stand and divided we fall, and that fear is destructive to the human soul and the soul of these United States of America. Fort Worth City Council Redistricting Update

At a time when we are seeing universities such as Texas Christian, the University of Texas, Texas A&M and others and major corporations throughout the U.S. recognizing the importance of inclusion and diversity and are desperately doing everything possible to make that a reality, why can't our local government do the same thing? It makes sense that student bodies and a corporation's workforce reflect the population served and for local government to reflect the population it serves or purports to represent. Doing that would indicate that all segments of the population have a voice in their government. In Fort Worth that starts at the city council, where policy that affects everything in the city originates; if we had that it would be an example of what is democracy—what one of our greatest U.S. presidents once so eloquently articulated in a famous speech: 'government of the people, by the people and for the people.'

If people look at who presently sits on the Fort Worth City Council, it is obvious that it is not even close to reflecting the city's diverse population.

It is reasonable to expect that a goal such as this one cannot be achieved overnight. But at the very least, there must be a policy in place detailing specific steps that must be taken by specific times to get us closer to achieving that goal, and someone must be held accountable or nothing will happen.

In our ever-evolving democracy, where we still have too much political polarization, distrust, anger, frustration and resentment between races and ethnic groups, which has been festering for multi-generations that can be easily stoked by demagogues for political gain, it is time for reconciliation. We are all human beings and must find common ground to heal what

divides us or we will all pay the price.

As a city we need to have a policy in place that truly respects our differences and reflects our diversity. To not have one is to invite more unrest in the future. Not only does our city council need to better reflect all segments of the population, but also all departments of the city's workforce, including the police department. (In regard to the latter, I say this after having worked with police officers as a member of Citizens of Patrol since 1992 and I am still patrolling on foot today—to rid our neighborhood of a variety of problems. I have observed that most of our police officers are definitely not racists and perform their duties in a professional and outstanding manner. I have nothing but good things to say about the effectiveness of community policing. What I hear on the street all the time is that we have made a lot of progress and now have more Hispanic officers on the beats. Many Hispanic speaking residents appreciate that because it helps them communicate better with the police department. I know that there has been much improvement in this area in the last few years. Despite that, at this time I am trying to have an "Open Records Request" processed to look at the latest city workforce numbers, broken down by race/ ethnicity.)

As a veteran of redistricting battles, when I first heard about "Citizen Independent Redistricting" and then did some research, I, as others have, saw it as a tool to increase inclusion and diversity on the Fort Worth City Council. Many people believe that the changes in the city's population demographics in the last decade—which indicates that our city is now majority minority—calls for a new approach to redistricting that can have a better chance of resulting in a more diverse city council.

The obstacle we face is that the mayor and a majority of the city council members do not want to change. No matter how they spin it, they want to continue drawing city council maps. This is being done even though "Citizen Independent Redistricting" was one of the

recommendations made to the city council by the Race and Culture Task Force.

The city manager has stated that he is implementing this recommendation. So, to repeat what I have said, the bottom line is that nothing has changed from what has been done after previous census cycles. Again, the city council will still do redistricting. But this time, it has appointed an 11-member "Redistricting Task Force" to advise them on the "redistricting criteria and procedures" they need to follow. Keep in mind that this time the number of city council districts will increase from 8 to 10.

The following people have been recently appointed to the Redistricting Task Force: Place 1 Mayor Betsy Price; Lorraine Miller, Chair; Place 2: Salvador Espino; Place 3: Graham Norris; Place 4: Craig Allen; Place 5: Bert Williams; Place 6: Linda Kennedy; Place 7: Tony DeVito; Place 8: Tracy Scott; Place 9: Kent Bradshaw; Place 10: Bill Schur; Place 11: Teresa Ayala

Below is the timeline for the Redistricting Task Force:

December 8, 2020—Present an interim report on their findings to the city council. Prior to this date there will be several public hearings that will allow the task force to receive input.

January 2021—Multiple Public Hearings will be scheduled, either physically or virtually, at locations throughout the city to solicit community feedback on redistricting criteria and procedures.

March 2, 2020—Redistricting Task Force makes its final recommendations to the city council.

Task force meetings are open to the public.

Does what the city is planning look like 'citizen independent redistricting' to anyone? Hint: Citizen Independent Redistricting would keep incumbent city council members from drawing their own council districts, which in Fort Worth has always been about

protecting their interests first rather than what is in the best public interest. Another hint: Look at what was done in Austin before their 2014 election.

There is no doubt that change of any type is difficult and when it involves giving up political power it is even more difficult.

To say that we are disappointed with the city's plan is an understatement. But things are what they are, and we can still have an impact like we have in previous census cycles. Unlike in previous census cycles, this time the city's final plan will not require pre-clearance under Sec. 5 of the Voting Rights Act (VRA) by the U.S. Dept. of Justice before going into effect. (Since it was adopted in 1965, much has been added to the VRA, including the impact of court rulings (case law). My opinion is that few people know that the Voting Rights was intended to give minorities such as Blacks, Hispanics, Native Americans, and others voting rights and this needs to be the first consideration in any redistricting plan. I have been dismayed that in previous census cycles some city council members did not seem to be aware of this. Some were not even aware of, for example, that race and ethnic groups "Communities of Interest" are at the top of the hierarchy and must be considered first when drawing maps.

Although pre-clearance under Sec.5 is no longer required, the city's plan must still adhere to the provisions of Section 2 of the VRA. We will be drawing our own maps and watching the city's map and if not done right we will go to court.


Redistricting may seem daunting at first. I probably know more about it than most because I have been involved in it for a long time. There will be other articles in the future to keep you informed.

What I know for sure now is that we will need the support of many people and I will also get into that later. Right now, please forward this article to your contacts. To those not on our list now, please shoot me your email address and I will put you on our list for future updates.
