Hispanic Heritage Month: Celebrating Ignorance or Culture?

Gore Vidal once said that "American's lack of education is the joke of the world." When you look into the origin and use of the term "Hispanic," you might agree with Gore Vidal. Supposedly the word "Hispanic" was coined by Grace Flores Hughes, a food-stamp worker back in the 1970s who erroneously believed that everyone that has a Spanish surname is of Spanish descent. She also erroneously believed that South Texans were Spanish. The last time I checked the vast majority of the Spanish-surnamed South-Texans were of Mexican descent.

Why was the word "Hispanic" preferred over the word "Latino"? Supposedly the term "Latino" was too broad and included Mediterranean peoples from places like Portugal, and Italy. Well aren't the Spanish also a Mediterranean nation, Portugal was a part of Spain at one time, and Spain was a part of Italy during Roman times. Also Spaniards are not a significant population in the United States, the majority of Spanish surnamed peoples are actually Mexican-Americans, Americans of Mexican descent.

The term "Hispania" was used by the Phoenicians and later by the Romans to refer to the Iberian Peninsula. Yet not everyone in Spain considers himself a Spaniard, and not everyone speaks Spanish as their mother tongue, for example the Basque and Catalans. The forefathers of Basque-Americans came from Spain, but I would not risk calling them Spanish-Americans. They are Basque-Americans. What about the Native-Americans in the southwest who have Spanish surnames, are they "Hispanic," are they Spanish-Americans?



How about the Filipino-Americans or the people of Guam who have Spanish surnames, are they Spanish-Americans. Are they Asians or Hispanics?

You can't blame a food-stamp worker with a limited education for abusing words to label people with a broad brush, she did the best with the poor education she received. The federal government census actually started using the term "Hispanic" in 1980. Yet if we are to celebrate a Heritage month we need to be specific about what heritage we are celebrating, "Hispanic" is a vague term and too misleading. For example, "Hispanics" didn't create Mexican food, it was the Mexican culture that created that food, and 90% percent of that food is a heritage of Native-American cultures, tortillas, tamales, and most Mexican food originates in Native-America. The Mariachi wasn't created by "Hispanics," it was purely the Mexican genius that created this music. The Puerto-Rican culture, the Cuban Culture, the Cultures of Central and South America. they all have their unique heritages. They cannot all be lumped in together and called "Hispanic," because it's not reality.

Why does the average Spanish-surnamed American call himself Hispanic? Basically, for two reasons: First reason is due to the ignorance and laugh-

able education that Gore Vidal referred to, people just repeat what they hear on television or school, without questioning anything; Second reason is sadly due to shame. Many of these people have a traumatic history in the USA, they or their parents were shamed for being of a specific race or culture. Some Mexican-Americans are ashamed of their Mexican heritage and prefer to call themselves "Hispanic" to hide their Mexican roots. COVID-19:

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Forks On The Road

Forks on the road.

I shall be telling tis with a sigh Somewhere ages and ages hence: Two roads diverged in a wood, and I -I took the one less traveled by, And that has made all the difference. Robert Frost.

It was not a trek down memory lane. Yet sometimes it is good to look back and see what got me where I am today.

Change is a word that we hear constantly. Somehow change is all around us. Especially right now with the corona virus. I wanted to see how change had affected my life. I took a trip to Morton Texas looking for remnants of the last school I attended, Neely Ward Elementary School. Neely Ward was a one room schoolhouse out in the cotton fields near the New Mexico border. It was a one room schoolhouse with one teacher. I recall the lady taught more than one grade. There was no principal, counselor, or any type of administrative support. According to my high school transcript, it was one of 24 public schools that I attended prior to enrolling at Burleson Elementary School in Edgewood ISD. I was about 10 years old. Neely Ward gone like the wind, is like Orange Grove just a distant memory.

In North Texas and Orange Grove I went to school with mostly White kids. I did not make friends with the White kids, but I did not experience any discrimination either. For lunch I always ate tacos. It was a novelty to White kids. They were always inquisitive as to what I was eating. They were eager to trade their sandwiches for tacos.

I recall one year that we did what we were used to doing, pack the truck and head north to the cotton fields. Still a boy, I did what most children my age did, follow their parents. The living conditions were never ideal, but it was a living and there was no other alternative. You do not pick cotton, you starve. There was no

welfare state. This year was different, there was no cotton to pick. The cotton-picking machine replaced the cotton pickers. The machine picked up the cotton we normally picked. Our way of sustenance was gone.

The cotton-picking machine changed our lifestyle. We were no longer cotton pickers. We had been replaced by a machine. It was a radical change. Our lifestyle would no longer be rural. We became urban dwellers. San Antonio was our new home. Orange Grove, our winter homeland was a distant memory. With the road most taken blocked, my father took the road less traveled. We had been victimized by change.

The road less taken had many potholes. Urban dwelling was a lifestyle that was new unknown and mysterious. I was not so young that I did not know that we no longer had the income from cotton picking. To earn money for the family I became a scavenger, going from dump to dump looking for copper, bronze, and lead that I would sell. Whatever money I made went to my mother for food. When you are fighting for survival you do not have time to be frightened.

We adapted to urban life. This time I went to the same school all year. No more checking in and out between cotton fields. School in San Antonio was different. I did not fit well with the other students. I did not speak local pachuco language and I had a very Mexican accent. I was not used to the urban lifestyle. I was an outcast.

The next fork in the road the decision as to which fork to take would be mine. I was no longer a child. I was called into the Dean's office at Edgewood HS one day early in my senior year. I was notified that I was being suspended from school for playing hooky. I did not even know what the word meant. I learned fast. I was skipping school. Never was I asked for a reason for not attending school. There was no attempt to call my parents. So, I was being suspended from school for not attending illegally, but I was going

to be suspended from school, so I did not have to attend legally. You cannot get more stupid than that. I had never gotten into any trouble all the time I went to school. I was livid. The dean had made up his mind, all he wanted me to do was sign the paperwork. I just said that I was quitting and walked out.

This would be the first fork of my adult life. In high school I was a member of the band. I had also joined the Naval Reserve. I joined the Navy not because my brother was in the Navy but because on Saturday's I used to be in front of the TV watching Roger Staubach play for the Naval Academy. My band playing was good enough for the district music superintendent to assure me I had a music scholarship at Trinity or St. Mary's. I was in a difficult position. The Naval Reserve wanted me to finish high school. To motivate me they were willing to send me to San Diego Navy Base to teach me a lesson. I had two choices, go back to school, and take a suspension or take a 90-day trip to San Diego Navy Base. I did not like either choice.

One evening an Army recruiter came to visit about me joining the Army. I had not considered joining the Army at all. I was not ready to consider this choice. I listened, not really interested in what he had to offer. When he was done, The Army recruiter explained that he could get me out of the Naval Reserve. I told him he had 24 hours to get me into the Army. If he did not get me in to destroy all paperwork and not return. Next morning, he came for me. I went to the recruiting station. I took all the battery of tests, I took the physical exam, was sworn in and that evening I was on my way to Fort Carson Co. for basic training. I never looked back. The Army was my immediate challenge.

This would be the first fork in the road for me. There would be more.

Yet during this COVID-19 pandemic I have experienced nothing but government employees cowering behind COVID-19. It seems they can not do anything because of COVID-19. My granddaughter who graduated from high School class of 2020 was unable to enroll at North Central Texas Community College because of not being able to obtain a state I.D. The appointment at the Department of Motor Vehicles to obtain her driver license was set for October even though she had already completed her driver education classes and required hours of driving. Without a state ID, she was unable to register at NCTC. She now plans to enroll in the Spring. I think the DPS could do a better job of providing ID and drivers licenses even in this pandemic.

I protested my property taxes with the appraisal District. I submitted my protests regarding the properties that I own, in one single packet as I had done for the past 20 years. Instead of scheduling me for one appointment they had set up separate appointments at different times, dates with some appointment times even overlapping others. After several calls to the appraisal district someone finally answered the phone. I explained to the person my situation.

She informed me because of COVID-19 that is how it had to be. I could not accept that answer, so I requested to speak to a supervisor. The supervisor had the same answer: COVID-19. After explaining the unreasonableness of the situation, the supervisor finally scheduled me for one appointment. All the paper and cost of mailing the separate appointments was cost to the taxpayer. How many times has this been done with property owners that have multiple properties at the expense of the taxpayers?

I know of a property owner who was trying to recover possession of a property because the tenant had not paid rent for over 5 months which including dates prior to COVID-19. He had contacted the JP court to get the forms he needed for the process. He was told he would have to do it online because of COVID-19. Since he had no experience how to do it, much less online, he contacted me for help. I called the JP office and inquired about the forms. I was told that it would all have to be done online, because of COV-ID-19. I then asked if a person does not have a computer or does not know how to access the JP Court page what does he do? After several minutes of discourse, the attendant stated that the property owner could come by the office and they would meet him outside and give him the applications, as another option. Why was this not told to him the first time he called?

I needed to have the utilities turned on in a certain residence. I called the City of Denton Municipal Utilities for a couple of days, several times a day with no response. On the third day after calling a couple of times, I decided to go and get the utilities turned on in person.


Only one window was open and several people standing in line. While standing in line, I could hear people laughing and joking behind the shutter partition at the customer service window. When I finally arrived at the window, I requested the utilities be turned on and asked why only one window was open and why the phone was not being answered. I got the standard answer: COVID-19. I asked to speak to a supervisor and expressed my concerns about no one answering the phone for the past 3 days, only one window open and people laughing and joking behind the shutter while people waited in line. Again, the supervisor tried to use COVID-19 but I stated that answer was unacceptable and walked out.

These are only a few of my experiences with government during the COVID-19 pandemic. I have talked with others who are just as frustrated as me when it comes to dealing with government agencies during this pandemic. While many citizens are working and dealing with the pandemic, government employees have taken the attitude that they are not required to work if there is the slightest chance of being exposed to the COVID-19 virus. This is not acceptable to me and many citizens who see our taxes being used for salaries while we are getting poor service in return. It is time our elected officials require the government employees to provide the services they are being paid to provide. Government officials must look outside the box for solutions to provide services to the citizens of Denton using common sense such as many private business owners have done.
